WHO DO WE NEED TO TALK TO?

Mums, Dads, or main caregivers of children aged 0 - 18yrs with a disability and medically complex cares which might include:

- tube feeds
- seizure management
- suction or breathing support
- giving lots of medications

WHAT WILL WE TALK ABOUT?

- We can talk about anything to do with in-home support or respite care
- We can talk online or in person, at a time that suits you
- We can use an interpreter from The Royal Children's Hospital

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

- Interviews can take between 40 - 60 minutes
- If you need to stop to take care of your child that is okay
